MINUTES OF THE FOURTH MULTIPLE COUNCIL MEETING April 30th & 1st May 2026

Venue: HOTEL GOKULAM PARK, AVINASHI ROAD, COIMBATORE

1. Meeting Called to Order

Lion Dr.P.Ayyadurai, Multiple Council Chairperson called the Fourth Multiple Council Meeting to Order.

2. Lions Prayer
