## **MINUTES OF THE SECOND MULTIPLE COUNCIL MEETING**

**19th & 20th NOVEMBER 2025**

**Venue : HOTEL KODAI INTERNATIONAL, KODAIKANAL**

**1. Meeting Called to Order :**

**PMJF Dr. P.Ayyadurai**, Multiple Council Chairperson called the Second Multiple Council Meeting to Order.

**2. Lions Prayer**

Lions Prayer was rendered by First Vice District Governor (Dist 3242 B) **Lion Dr.N.Arumugam**

**3. Silent Prayer**

Council Members observed one minute silent prayer for the cause of World Peace.

**4. Welcome Address :**

**PMJF Dr. P.Ayyadurai**, Multiple Council Chairperson, requested District Governor **Lion D. Selvam** (DG 3242B) to deliver the welcome address.

District Governor **Lion D. Selvam** (DG 3242B) warmly welcomed the Multiple Council Chairperson, International Director **PMJF Subash Babu**, Past International Directors, Council Office Bearers, Council of Governors, First Vice District Governors, Second Vice District Governors, the GAT Team, and all Past District Governors present at the Council Meeting.

**5. Roll Call :**

7. **Approval of the Minutes of the First Council Meeting:**

Multiple Council Chairman **PMJF Dr. P. Ayyadurai** requested to approve the Minutes of the First Council Meeting. The Minutes were approved unanimously by the Council Members.

8. **Opening Remarks by Multiple Council Chairman :**

The Multiple Council Chairman in his opening remarks he expressed his happiness in welcoming all members and thanked them for their gracious presence. He extended a warm welcome to International Director **PMJF Subhash Babu** from Andhra Pradesh, mentioning that the International Director is well acquainted with all our Past International Directors and Past District Governors, many of whom are his close friends and welcomed PID's, ID Endorsee, area leaders, DG Team and Council members, GAT Area Leader and especially District 316 GAT Area Leader **PMJF Upendra**.

During his address, the Multiple Council Chairman congratulated the Governors of Districts 3242F, 3242B, 3242E, 3242A, and 3242C for their strong support towards Mission 1.5 and LCIF. He highlighted that Multiple District 3242 has more than 37,000 members and proudly noted that the International President's own district holds first place in membership, while Multiple District 3242 holds second place globally. He concluded by congratulating all Council Members for their dedicated service and contributions towards the achievements of Multiple District 3242.

9. **Welcome of International President by MCC:**

Following his opening remarks, the Multiple Council Chairman informed that a Zoom meeting is being conducted with our International President, **PMJF A.P. Singh**. The MCC warmly welcomed the International President and all other dignitaries participating in the Zoom meeting. He also informed the gathering that International Director **PMJF Subhash Babu** is present with us as the Chief Guest..

10. **Zoom meeting of International President PMJF A.P. SINGH :**

In his address, Our International President appreciated ID **Lion Subhash Babu**, all the Council Members and his close friends from **Multiple District 3242** for their commitment and dedication.

He mentioned that Board Appointee **Lion Sangeetha Jatia** and **Lion Kayal** were also present at the meeting.

He strongly urged all leaders and members to actively engage in club responsibilities with passion at the Club, District, and Multiple levels, emphasizing that membership growth is the foundation for organizational strength.

He highlighted that leaders are the engine and pilots of growth, stating that membership growth is **not merely a number**, but a **source of strength** that enables the organization to effectively implement meaningful service projects. Increasing membership enhances the ability to serve more people worldwide.

The International President further in his speech the importance of inducting young members and women for sustainable and balanced growth. He encouraged the transition of *Leos into Lions* by forming Leo–Lions Clubs, adding new members to existing clubs and establishing new clubs within the districts.

He further emphasized that clubs under financial suspension should be motivated and supported to become active clubs, or, if necessary, be revoked from suspension in accordance with organizational norms.

He also requested leaders to give special attention to clubs with fewer than 10 members and those with 11 to 19 members, to induct new members and strengthen them, thereby building strong clubs and powerful districts.

Multiple Council Secretary **PMJF Er. A. Savari Raj** submitted the Administrative Report.

#### **12. Financial Report by Council Treasurer PMJF Dr.R.Nithyanandam:**

Council Treasurer **PMJF Dr.R.Nithyanandam** Submitted the Financial report. He told that the copies of the Income and Expenditure Statement had already been distributed to all members. It was informed that there was a minor clerical error in the budget, wherein the amount was mentioned as Rs.1,23,00,000 instead of Rs. 1,25,00,000. The receivables were reported as Rs. 50,30,848.

The Multiple Council Chairman requested the Council to approve the Financial Report, and the same was unanimously approved by Council Members.

#### **13. Chief Guest ID PMJF Subhash Babu**

International Director **Lion Subhash Babu** in his chief guest address congratulated International Director **Lion S. Magesh**, Multiple Council Chairman **Lion P.
